Proclamation

- WHEREAS,** the Baton Rouge Chapter of the Association of Government Accountants (AGA) is a professional organization which has a network of 15,000 members and approximately 165 active members representing state, federal, municipal and private sector accountants, auditors, and financial managers in Louisiana; and
- WHEREAS,** AGA Baton Rouge Chapter members support AGA's mission of advancing government accountability and continuing its broad educational efforts, with emphasis on high standards of conduct, honor, and character in its Code of Ethics; and
- WHEREAS,** AGA Baton Rouge Chapter members are making significant advances in professional ability and service to the citizens of Louisiana by mastering increasingly technical and complex requirements; and

- NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Bobby Jindal, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim March 2013 as


